Buses*	The number 5, 5A and X5 stop on Melton Road which is a 5 minute walk from the school. These buses connect Melton Mowbray with Leicester, stopping at the various villages between the two.
Rail*	The school is located between two train stations both a 10 minute drive from the school, Sileby to the north and Syston to the south. This line connects with Leicester and Loughborough train station.
Roads*	The school is located in a small village to the north of Leicester, the school is close to Melton Road which will connect with the nearby town of Melton Mowbray, the A607 which will connect to Leicester as well as the Leicester Western Bypass which will connect to the West of the City including the M1.
Walking Routes*	The school is located in a small village, there is a good standard of pavements around the village connecting to the school.
Cycling Routes*	There are no segregated cycle lanes around the school, however the road and pavements around the village are suitable for pupils, parents and staff to ride on.
