OVER THE UKS2 CHILDREN'S LEARNING IN ART SHOULD INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- ✓ Using a range of materials creatively to design and make products
 - ✓ Drawing, painting, sculpture and digital media
 - ✓ Improving artwork following feedback
- ✓ Discussing diverse range of artists, craft makers and designers artwork (including digital artists) using visual language.

BY THE END OF UKS2 A CHILD ATTAINING TYPICALLY WILL BE ABLE TO:

- Create a colour palette based upon colours observed in the natural or built world.
- Use a variety of techniques to add interesting effects (e.g. reflections, shadows, direction of sunlight).
- Use a choice of techniques to depict movement, perspective, shadows and reflection.
- Use a number of brush techniques using thick and thin brushes to produce shapes, textures, patterns and lines.
- Use the qualities of watercolour and acrylic paints to create visually interesting pieces.
- Combine colours, tones and tints to enhance the mood of a piece.
- Create precise collages using a range of materials (including ceramic) that use coiling, overlapping, tessellation, mosaic and montage.
- Use a range of materials and tools to create sculptures that have a recognisable form, as appropriate use frameworks (such as wire or moulds) to provide stability and form.
- Use print to create an accurate pattern, showing fine detail.
- Choose from a range of stitching techniques.
