## What does History look like at St Michael & All Angels?

Children to be able to discuss and apply historical concepts from previous years, eg the concept of Empire with the Romans in Y3/4 and the British Empire in Y5/6.

Trips for the children to explore the area they have learnt in greater depth such as Y5/6 trip to the Imperial War Museum and Y3/4 trip to Wollaton Hall.

A range of assessments used across the curriculum – essay writing in KS2, retrieval practise at the start each lesson and multiple choice quizzes.

A scheme of work to follow, clearly mapping out objectives and progression across the whole school.
